CONTROL AND MANAGEMENT OF FIRES

Control and Management of Fires - Village Ordinance, Section 2.09

**When ready to burn, please call Bayside Dispatch (non-emergency) 351-9900 and they will send an officer to inspect the burn site and issue a permit.

PERMITS ISSUED ONLY FOR BURNING:

- Grass, hay, weeds, brush or similar materials
- Over 100 feet away from any building or structure
- In area where fire spread is not reasonably anticipated
- There is a water hose or supply available to wet down area in vicinity of fire
- Winds are at 10 mph or lower
- Fire is monitored at all times

If the request is to burn an area of grass/prairie, the North Shore Fire Department must be contacted (Fire Chief Whitaker #357-0113) and must agree to the safety of the burn.

Do NOT use gasoline to start a fire.

Do NOT make large bon fires, keep fire at a manageable level.

Do NOT burn if winds increase above 10 mph.

Do NOT burn after dark.

Be aware of fire brands or embers which may be carried upward & descend in another area presenting a fire hazard.

After burning is complete, douse coals and embers with liberal amounts of water. Ensure that the fire is out and that it will not rekindle.
