ORDINANCE NO. 533

An Ordinance to Create Subsection 16.06 (5) of Chapter Sixteen of the General Ordinances of The Village of River Hills Relating To Alcohol Beverage Regulation

The Village Board of the Village of River Hills, Milwaukee County, do ordain as follows:

Section I. Subsection 16.06 (5) of Chapter 16 of the General Ordinances of the Village of River Hills is hereby created to read as follows:

(5) <u>Temporary Operator's License</u> – Temporary operator's licenses may be granted to individuals pursuant to §125.17(4), Wisconsin Stats., by the Village Board for the purpose of allowing said individuals to dispense and serve alcohol beverages under a license issued under §125.26(6) or §125.51(10), Wisconsin Stats., to a non-profit organization. No person may hold more than one license of this kind per year. Any temporary operator license issued under this section shall be valid for any period from one (1) to fourteen (14) days, and the period for which it is valid shall be on the license. The fee for said license shall be set by Village Board resolution.

Section II. If any subsection, section or portions of this article or the sections of this ordinance as enacted hereunder is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portions shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

Section III. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are to such extent repealed.

Section IV. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication as provided by law.
