

NOTICE OF REFERENDUM
GLENDALE-RIVER HILLS SCHOOL DISTRICT
APRIL 2, 2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that at an election to be held in the Glendale-River Hills School District on April 2, 2019, the following proposed Revenue Limit Resolution of the School Board will be submitted to a vote of the people:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SCHOOL
DISTRICT BUDGET TO EXCEED REVENUE
LIMIT BY \$1,580,000 PER YEAR FOR FIVE
YEARS FOR NON-RECURRING PURPOSES

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Glendale-River Hills School District, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin that the revenues included in the School District budget be authorized to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$1,580,000 per year for the 2020-2021 school year through the 2024-2025 school year, for non-recurring purposes in order to maintain District programs.

The question will appear on the ballot as follows:

“Shall the Glendale-River Hills School District, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin be authorized to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$1,580,000 per year for the 2020-2021 school year through the 2024-2025 school year, for non-recurring purposes in order to maintain District programs?”

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT AND EFFECT OF VOTE

The referendum election ballot will ask District electors to vote “yes” or “no” on the referendum election question as set forth above.

A “yes” vote on the question is a vote to authorize the Glendale-River Hills School District budget to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$1,580,000 per year for the 2020-2021 school year through the 2024-2025 school year, for non-recurring purposes in order to maintain District programs.

A “no” vote on the question is a vote to deny the Glendale-River Hills School District the authority to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$1,580,000 per year for the 2020-2021 school year through the 2024-2025 school year, for non-recurring purposes in order to maintain District programs.

In the event a majority of the electors voting on the question vote “yes”, the District will be authorized to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$1,580,000 per year for the 2020-2021 school year through the 2024-2025 school year, for non-recurring purposes in order to maintain District programs; if a majority vote “no” on the question set forth above, the District will not be so authorized.
