

**ORDINANCE NO. 497**

**An Ordinance to Amend Subsection 7.1003.E of Chapter  
Seven (7) of the General Ordinances of the Village of  
River Hills Relating to Voting Requirements of the Board of Appeals**

The Village Board of the Village of River Hills, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

**SECTION I.** That Subsection 7.1003.E of Chapter Seven (7) of the General Ordinances of the Village of River Hills is hereby amended to read as follows:


“E. If a quorum is present the Board may take action by a majority vote of the members present. The grounds of every determination to reverse any order, requirement, decision or determination of any administrative officer or to decide in favor of the applicant any matter upon which it is required to pass or to effect any variation shall be stated.”

**SECTION II.** In the event that it is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction that any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part, of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional that shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts to this Ordinance.


**SECTION III.** That all ordinances, or parts of ordinances, conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby to such extent repealed.

**SECTION IV.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
