

ORDINANCE NO. 499

**An Ordinance Amending Ordinance 495 Regarding the Creation
Of Chapter 19 of the General Ordinances of the Village of River
Hills to Authorize the Health Department to Enforce State Laws
Relating to Environmental Health and Sanitation.**

WHEREAS, the Village Board adopted Ordinance No. 495 an ordinance regarding environmental health and sanitation on January 17, 2006; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 495 in Section VI provided that the ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law and upon adoption of an ordinance in substantially the same form by all member communities of the North Shore Health Department and the member communities of the Shorewood/Whitefish Bay Health Department; and

WHEREAS, The City of Glendale a member community of the North Shore Health Department has advised the other member communities that it will not adopt an ordinance in substantially the same form at this time; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the North Shore Health Department has requested that the Village Board take steps to put Ordinance 495 into effect without the necessity of the other communities adopting a substantially similar ordinance; and

WHEREAS, in order for Ordinance No. 495 to go into effect Section IV of Ordinance No. 495 must be amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Village Board of the Village of River Hills, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:


SECTION I. That Section VI of Ordinance No. 495 of the General Ordinances of the Village of River Hills adopted on January 17, 2006 is amended to read as follows:

“This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.”


SECTION II. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby to such extent repealed.
