

## FILLING AND EXCAVATING PERMITS

Are required when a resident is moving more than 20 cubic yards per acre of lot. (For a 5 acre lot, that's 100 cubic yards.)

Contractor or owner must complete and sign an application form and **submit payment**.

Must provide plans for their work showing the topography, existing site & proposed changes and location for the silt fence. PLANS MUST BE APPROVED BY THE VILLAGE ENGINEER PRIOR TO ISSUING PERMIT.

If the contractor will be doing heavy trucking, especially in spring, check with Randy Groth, Public Works Superintendent about whether or not a road bond will be required. (This is a bond purchased to reimburse the Village for damage to roads especially as the ground thaws.)

If the contractor will be installing culverts, Randy needs to give his approval and a separate permit issued.

Work hours for heavy trucking and equipment are 8:00 am – 5:00 pm, Monday through Saturday. No Sundays or holidays.

### PRICING

Culvert Permits are \$110.00. See attached Chapter 11.02 of the Village Ordinance.

Filling and Excavating Permits are \$150.00 for the first 30 days, and \$50.00 for each 30 days beyond that to a maximum of six months. See attached Chapter 15 of the Village Ordinance.
