BUILDING BOARD MINUTES Monday, February 18, 2020 @ 5:00 pm

Members present: Tony Enea (chairman), Susan Muggli, Vic Harding, Walt Nielsen, Harvey Meisel, Chris Meisel, and Ray Juehring. Also present: Building Inspector Tod Doebler and Village Deputy Clerk Stephanie Waala.

1. Approval of minutes from the January 20, 2020 meeting.

Motion by Nielsen and seconded by Harding to approve; motion carried unanimously.

2. Discussion/action on the fence addition at the Crivello residence, 8405 N Pelican Ln.

Contractor Thomas Lied present

- 14-foot opening in existing fence to be closed and made into a U shape seating area
 - \circ 6' tall cedar fence (4' 1"x6" channel board and then 2' of lattice on top) color Quiver tan
 - Same as existing
- 5-foot by 5-foot gas fire pit to be installed in center of new U shape seating area
 - Walls and top to be made of granite color dark brown mahogany
 - o Kichler LED light fixtures with brackets to be installed under the top lip of the granite topper
- 4 tree underlighting flood lights to be reused and 2 additionally purchased
 - o Replacement of bulbs with lower wattage to give more of a moon light effect

Motion by Juehring and seconded by Muggli to approve; motion carried unanimously.

3. Discussion/action on the front porch addition and window reworking at the Ferrer residence, 8575 N River Rd.

Homeowner Jose Ferrer present Architect Meg Baniukiewicz present.

- 15 feet 3 inches wide by 7 feet 8 inches deep covered porch
 - o Cedar posts color to match existing wood on home
 - Standing seam roof made of copper
- 2 bay windows on both sides of the front door to be replaced with 2 Marvin casement windows on each side – color bronze
 - o Brick to match existing will be used to fill in size difference

- 3 Simpson 7504 double french doors to replace doors on front entry (active leaf) and 2 in the rear of the home (1 active leaf and 1 fixed panels)
- 1 Simpson 7504 single french door to replace double slider door on rear of home
- Vaughn Kingston Wall Lantern light fixtures to be install outside of the new doors

Motion by Harding and seconded by Juehring to approve; motion carried unanimously.

4. Discussion/action on the installation of a solar array at the Gose residence, 675 W Dean Rd.

Item tabled until next meeting due to no representative present and awaiting approval from the Board of Appeals on location.
