






WIS 57 AND WIS 100 BROWN DEER ROAD AND GREEN BAY ROAD FEBRUARY 2022

CONSTRUCTION BEGINS EARLY MARCH

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation will begin construction along Brown Deer Road and Green Bay Road, including reconstructing the WIS 100/WIS 57 interchange into an at-grade intersection, as well as resurfacing 3.4 miles of Green Bay Road. Work will begin early march. Watch for closures and signed detour routes.



UPCOMING CLOSURES EARLY MARCH THROUGH FALL 2022

- Southbound WIS 57 traffic must exit to WIS 100 and follow detour
- Northbound WIS 57 at Teutonia no northbound access to WIS 100
- Westbound WIS 100 to southbound WIS 57 at the interchange

ACCESS TO REMAIN OPEN

- Westbound/eastbound WIS 100 to northbound WIS 57 (Green Bay Road)
- Westbound WIS 100 median access to **Deerwood Drive**
- Eastbound WIS 100 to southbound WIS 57 (to close late March)
- Ruth Place to southbound WIS 57 (to close late March)



WORK IN 2022 TO INCLUDE:

- Remove the grade separation at WIS 57/ WIS 100 and build an at grade intersection,
- Construct Roundabout at intersection of Green Bay Road and Teutonia Avenue
- Reconstruct WIS 57 (Green Bay Road) from Teutonia Avenue to Deerwood Drive
- Reconstruct WIS 100 (Brown Deer Road) from WI Southern Rail Crossing west of Deerbrook Trail to Kildeer Court
- Rehabilitation of WIS 57 from Deerwood Drive to Mequon Road with intersection and signal improvements at Donges Bay Road
